The West Pride Bands have been exceptional for over fifty years. Shortly after the school opened it made its first appearance on the national scene by being invited to perform at the Mid-West Band and Orchestra Clinic in Chicago. Since then it has consistently received Superior ratings at state, regional and local music festivals and performed in front of international crowds on no less than ten occasions. The Marching Band has performed in the London New Year's Day Parade in London England. The Overland Express Jazz Ensemble has performed across the city entertaining thousands of people while also sharing the stage with some of the country's top performing Jazz soloists and ensembles. The Wind Ensemble was recently invited to perform at the Kauffman Center for the Performing Arts, home of the Kansas City Symphony. We have approximately 150 students involved in the band program at Shawnee Mission West.
